

## **Bible Reading for the Week of December 7, 2025**

### **Monday, December 8 – Ephesians 5:22-6:4**

How does the marriage bond between man and woman reflect the truths of the gospel? How does the relationship between Christ and his church help us think through the relational dynamics in marriage? Take time today to pray that the Lord would bless the marriages in the church.

### **Tuesday, December 9 – Ephesians 5:22-6:4**

What specific obligations are set forth for husbands? Wives? Children? Consider how you might grow in your respective duties in the home. In addition, take time to pray that God would provide godly spouses to those in the church who desire marriage.

### **Wednesday, December 10– Ephesians 5:22-6:4**

How does the covenantal structure of the Bible influence the homes represented in the church? How does this especially relate to the children of believers? Take time today to give thanks to the Lord for His promise to be a God to us and to our children.

### **Thursday, December 11– Psalm 103:1-5**

What are some of the things that David lists in verses 1-5 concerning what God has done for him? How do these realities relate to the Christian life? Praise the Lord today for the wonderful salvation that He has bestowed upon you.

### **Friday, December 12– Psalm 103:6-14**

What are some of the images that David provides for how God deals with our sin? Why do you think the Bible provides believers with so many different images? As you pray today, take time to bless the Lord for His fatherly love and compassion towards you

### **Saturday, December 13 – Psalm 103:15-22**

How does the love of God compare to man's existence? What is the relationship of the love of God to the children and grandchildren of believers? Why do you think this Psalm begins and ends with praise? Pray that the Lord would prepare your heart to worship Him tomorrow.
