Announcements

- **Fasting Fridays: We have begun "Fasting Fridays."** Join Pastor Andrew in prayer and fasting for God's Kingdom and especially Faith Church. The goal is to abstain from food and unnecessary distractions (technology, games, novels, etc.) for a certain period of time to pray. For instance, if you fast until lunch, the time you would normally spend on eating for breakfast you can spend in prayer instead. When you feel hungry, let that be a reminder to pray. End when you must. Pastor Andrew intends to fast until lunchtime. For those medically unable to fast, you can still join in the time of focused prayer and you can still give up some aspect of your morning routine. Fridays are an appropriate day to fast because it was the day that our Lord died. It reminds us both of the grace we receive through Jesus' atonement and that He calls us to self denial and His service until He returns in His power and glory.
- **Adult Sunday School Class: Come Join the Adult Sunday School Class** as we watch and discuss a 12 part series on Christianity & Liberalism from Ligonier Ministries. Written by J. Gresham Machen, this book is still applicable one hundred years later
