

Bible Reading for Week of January 12, 2025

Monday, January 13 – Psalm 16

Describe the soul satisfied in God (v1). What is both a result and evidence of being satisfied in God (v3)? How does the psalmist make use of the means of grace (vs.5, 7-8)? This is a daily discipline. How does grace affect him (vs.6, 9-11)?

Tuesday, January 14 – Psalm 73

Describe the flow of the psalmist's thinking – from envy to being satisfied in God. When has your thinking been distorted? How do you practice "God with you" (v 23)? Pray for the glory of God to shrivel worldly things that you've coveted (v25). How and when do you feed on God (v26)?

Wednesday, January 15 – Jeremiah 29: 1-14

How can you be satisfied in God while in exile? What is your proper response in the moment (vs.5-7)? When you are going through a long, dark valley, keep your eyes focused on the final future, promised by your Lord (vs. 11-14).

Thursday, January 16 – Psalm 98: 1-9

Why do God's people gather each week to praise Him, according to Psalm 98? Take time today to consider the marvelous things He has done for you through the work of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Friday, January 17 – Isaiah 25: 1-12

Consider the language Isaiah uses in vs 6-9. When will the final fulfillment of these verses take place? Are you longing for the second coming of Jesus Christ? If so, what is it about the coming of Christ that should cause us to "be glad and rejoice" (v 9)?

Saturday, January 18 – Hebrews 9: 15-28

According to the author of Hebrews, what has Christ done in his first coming (v26)? What is he going to do in his second coming (v 28)? Take time to prepare your heart for worshipping with God's people this Lord's Day, as we gather "eagerly waiting for him" (v28).
