

Bible Reading for the Week of November 2, 2025

Monday, November 3 – Ephesians 4:17-24

How does sin affect the mind, according to verses 17-19? How does the redemption that comes through Jesus Christ affect the mind (see vss. 23-24)? Give thanks to the Lord for renewing your mind according to His Word.

Tuesday, November 4 – Ephesians 4:17-24

What does it mean for humanity to be made in the image of God? How does sin affect the image of God? In what way does redemption restore the present but marred image of God (see vs. 24)? Praise the Lord today that you have been made in His likeness to serve Him

Wednesday, November 5 – Romans 1:18-32

How do unbelievers respond to the clear revelation of God in the world? How do you see this suppression take place in the world? Take time today to ask that the Lord would continue to sanctify your mind so that you might *"think God's thoughts after him."*

Thursday, November 6 – Psalm 45:1-17

From whose perspective is this psalm being written? How does the speaker of the psalm characterize the king in verses 2-5? How are these qualities found in the Lord Jesus? Praise the Lord Jesus that he is your God and King.

Friday, November 7 – Psalm 45:1-17

How can the psalmist address the king as being God on the throne in verse 6? Spend time reflecting on how Jesus Christ is the most glorious and excellent king of his people.

Saturday, November 8 – Psalm 45:1-17

How does this psalm ultimately picture the relationship between Christ and his bride, the church (see Eph. 5:22-33)? As you prepare to worship with God's people tomorrow, praise the Lord for bringing you into His family.
