

Bible Reading for the Week of October 19, 2025

Monday, October 20 – Ephesians 4:1-6

What sorts of things has Paul said leading up to these verses that make it possible for Christians to "*walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which [they] have been called*" (vs. 1)? How does the grace of God undergird the calling of God in our lives? Take time today giving praise and thanks to God for His grace that enables you to walk in holiness.

Tuesday, October 21 – Ephesians 4:1-6

In the logic of this section, verses 2-3 provide the shape for what it looks to like to fulfill verse 1. How do verses 2-3 look different from a non-Christian's life? In what ways are these characteristics still lacking in your life? Pray and ask that the Spirit would work these things into your life more each day.

Wednesday, October 22 – Ephesians 4:1-6

What is the common theme that we find running through verses 4-6? How should diversity within the church (vs. 7) function with respect to the unity of the church (vss. 4-6)? Pray that the Lord would enable our church to be more and more united "*in the bond of peace*" (vs. 3).

Thursday, October 23 – Psalm 23:1-3

In what ways does the Lord shepherd His people, according to the opening three verses? Why does God lead His people in the way that He does (vs. 3)? Praise the Lord today that in Jesus Christ "*the Lord is [your] shepherd*" (vs. 1).

Friday, October 24 – Psalm 23:4

How does the brief phrase "*for you are with me*" provide great comfort for believers in Christ? In light of the coming of Christ, how is God "with us"? Take some time today to pray, asking that the Lord would make His presence with you known and felt.

Saturday, October 25 – Psalm 23:5-6

In what way might the Lord's Day (Christian Sabbath) be a fulfillment of Psalm 23:5? Take time today to ask the Lord that He would cause His blessing to overflow your cup as you gather with His people tomorrow
