Bible Reading for Week of September 8, 2024

Monday, September 9 – Revelation 1: 1-8

How does Jesus reveal himself about who he is (vs. 4-5, 8), what has he done (vs.5-6) and what is to come (v.7)? Let these truths give you hope this week as you grasp them by faith

Tuesday, September 10 – Revelation 1: 9-20

Jesus reveals himself in a way that you “feel” as much as know. How do these pictures of glory speak of his splendor in a way that simply stating facts might not? How can you claim his comfort as your king and priest walks with you in the middle of the lampstands?

Wednesday, September 11 – Revelation 4-5

The glorified lamb accomplishes God’s plan of salvation for his people! Such a big picture of redemption reminds you that our little lives and our little church are one beautiful but tiny speck in the mosaic of the Lord’s plan. How can the grand scope of the Lord’s plan for redemption bring you comfort this week?

Thursday, September 12 – Leviticus 25:1-24

What is a “Jubilee”? Why does the land need rest? How is this an expression of dependence and trust in the Lord like the weekly sabbath? Why does the Lord command a fresh start every fifty years for people and property alike? (vss. 17, 23, 36, 38, 42, 53, 55)

Friday, September 13 – Isaiah 61

After Isaiah’s prophecy, Israel will go into bondage in exile. He tells of the Lord’s servant who will proclaim the year of the Lord’s favor. How is this year a new Jubilee? Why did Jesus quote this verse at the beginning of his ministry (Luke 4:18-19)?

Saturday, September 14 – Matthew 6:19-34

How should you view your possessions in this world? How can you use them to seek first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness? Where in the manner of your things is the Lord calling you to trust him today (Leviticus 25:20-21)?
